

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH DUNDAS

BY-LAW NO. 2010-37

A By-law of the Corporation of the Township of South Dundas to regulate parking on property located at the intersection of Ottawa Street and County Road 4/Lakeshore Drive known municipally as 1 County Road 4/Lakeshore Drive (Morrisburg Dock and Boat Launch).

WHEREAS a municipally owned parking lot is located at the Morrisburg Dock and Boat Launch;

AND WHEREAS it has become apparent that the parking of vehicles in this lot must be regulated;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, a lower tier municipality may pass by-laws with regard to parking, except on Highways;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 101(1) if a municipality passes a by-law regulating or prohibiting the parking or leaving of a motor vehicle on land, it may provide for the removal and impounding or restraining and immobilizing of any vehicle, at the vehicle owner's expense, parked or left in contravention of the by-law and subsection 170 (15) of the *Highway Traffic Act* applies with necessary modifications to the by-law;

AND WHEREAS if signs are erected on land specifying conditions on which a motor vehicle may be parked or left on the land or regulating or prohibiting the parking or leaving of a motor vehicle on the land, a motor vehicle parked or left on the land contrary to the conditions or prohibition shall be deemed to have been parked or left without consent;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dundas deems it advisable to regulate parking at this location;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Dundas enacts as follows:

1. For the purposes of this by-law;
 - >" motor vehicle" includes an automobile, a motorcycle, a motor-assisted bicycle unless otherwise indicated in this Act, and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power;
 - >"trailer" means a vehicle that is at any time drawn upon a highway by a motor vehicle;
2. That the parking of trailers and/or motor vehicles for a continuous 24 hour period is not permitted.
3. Any trailer and/or any motor vehicle found to be parked in the parking lot for a continuous 24 hour period or more shall be deemed to be parked or left contrary to the by-law and may be removed and impounded at the owner's expense.
4. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of passing and the posting of signage specifying the conditions outlined herein.

5. That any by-law inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.
