**1. Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update**

CEMC Morehouse provided an overview of the press conference provided by Premier Ford and associated decisions regarding lifting Phase One restrictions put in place to combat the spread of COVID-19. Specifically, he noted the opening of limited outdoor recreational spaces, lifting of some restrictions associated with retail, and all restrictions related to construction. CEMC Morehouse noted that social distancing and all other measures are still in effect.

The Committee discussed opening procedures for facilities and spaces that are permitted to open according to direction from the Province, specifically municipal owned boat launches, campgrounds, tennis courts, dog parks and marina.

The Committee discussed enforcement over the long weekend and the need for continued education.
