

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTH DUNDAS

BY-LAW NO. 2020-82

A By-law to repeal and replace By-law No. 2005-07, being a By-law to regulate the operation of various off-road vehicles on Municipal Roads.

WHEREAS the *Highway Traffic Act, 1990* and Ontario Regulation 316/03 authorizes Municipalities to pass By-laws permitting various off-road vehicles to be operation on highways or part of highways within the Municipality and during specified month and hours as set out;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the best interest to regulate, govern and limit the operation of off-road vehicles within the Municipality;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of South Dundas enacts as follows:


1. Definitions

- 1.1. All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) – four wheeled vehicles, seat designed to be straddled by the operator, steering controls and carries only the driver.
 - 1.2. Side-by-Side – recreational vehicle with two seats abreast, with a hood and steering wheel.
 - 1.3. Extreme Terrain Vehicles (XTVs – 6 plus wheeled off-road vehicle (referred to as Argos).
 - 1.4. Off-Road Motorcycle (ORM) – two-wheeled off-road vehicle (referred to as dirt-bikes).
 - 1.5. Highway – includes common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lone thereof.
2. That all the provisions of Ontario Regulation 316/03 'Operation of Off-Road Vehicles on Highways' shall apply.
 3. That the operation of those Off-Road Vehicles described as All-Terrain Vehicle, Side-By-Side, Extreme Terrain Vehicles and Off-Road Motorcycles shall be permitted on those Municipal roads or portions thereof listed in Schedule 'A'.
 4. That the operation of All-Terrain Vehicle, Side-By-Side, Extreme Terrain Vehicles and Off-Road Motorcycles shall be permitted only during the hours specified in Schedule 'B'.
 5. That any person who contravenes any section of this By-law is guilty of a provincial offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided by the Provincial Offences Act.


6. That this By-lay shall come into full force and effect from the date of its passing.

Schedule 'A'

To By-law No. 2020-82

Permitted locations for the operation of off-road vehicles on Municipal roads:

1. All Municipal roads north of the King's Highway 401
2. Flagg Road from County Road 18 to County Road 2
3. Muttonville Road
4. Nudell Bush Road north of the King's Highway 401 to boundary
5. Marine Station Road
6. Broken Second Road north of County Road 2

Schedule 'B'

To By-law No. 2020-82

Permitted time of day for the operation of off-road vehicles on municipal roads:

1. Daily – permitted period from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
